FENSA is planning 5 technical seminars in the Autumn to support its Registered Businesses. Two technical seminars will be held in September and October, and one in November. Graham Hinett, Chief Executive at FENSA said, "Requests from FENSA's Registered Businesses for technical seminars have been increasing since the most recent changes in Building Regulations. The requests have been from businesses recently registered with FENSA but also from businesses that have been with FENSA for longer who are looking for a refresher course."

The format of the seminars will be a speaker presentation by an expert in the field, followed by a questions and answer session. As well as the speaker, there will be other experts on the panel to answer questions in their specific area of expertise. After the formal part of the event, there will be drinks and nibbles - a chance to network more informally with other Registered Businesses, members of the FENSA team, and BBA inspectors.

FENSA has been running a series of FREE Networking Happy Hour events during the summer which incorporates offering technical help and advice. The next Networking Happy Hour event will be held in Birmingham on the 18th July. There will be 10 minute 'surgery sessions' available on the day with a BBA inspector, to answer any specific technical questions the Registered Businesses may have.
